

Restarting an Android MIDI connection.

If you are having problems connecting, or are starting from scratch after the system has been switched off, this sequence should get things going.

1. On your Android Phone, select Settings/Network & Connection, and Bluetooth - turn ON
2. Tap Bluetooth and if, under PAIRED DEVICES, WIDI Master appears, whether connected or not, tap the adjacent gear (or daisy flower) symbol, then tap 'Forget' or 'Unpair' and confirm. Leave Settings
3. Open MIDI+BTLE - switch on your organ and check WIDI Master flashing blue – tap BLUETOOTH SCAN. WIDI Master should appear, tap it and then Pair and Connect. Accept the pairing. Blue should then be solid on WIDI Master. When complete, leave MIDI+BTLE running.
4. Start Synthesia, and select Settings/Music Devices. Under Music Output, tap WIDI Master and then set 'Send output to this device' to ON. Go back to Music Devices where WIDI Master should be showing 'Everything'
5. Go to Synthesia/Play a Song. Select a tune and press 'Play'. The tune should play on the organ, and possibly on the phone's internal synthesizer – if so, go to Synthesia/Settings/Music Devices and for entries under Music Output other than WIDI Master, tap their names and set 'Send output to this device' to OFF.

You can show the Piano Roll display by tapping 'Continue' at the top right of the Play a Song screen, and then the 'Watch and Listen Only' box.
